



1. Here is a great project for a parent and child or any beginning artist.




2. You will need bold colored drawing materials of any kind.

The faces are loading. Please be patient. Scroll down to see them all.





3. Draw a circle in the center of a sheet of paper.



4. Draw a circle in the center of a sheet of paper.



5. Then try to copy one of the faces in the center of the circle.



6. Next use lots of colors to draw curvy lines radiating from the circumference of the circle.



7. Let the child help you draw the radiating design.



8. Now draw circles in the middle of two more sheets of paper and indicate to your child that he or she can copy one of the faces while you copy another one.



9. Let the child do their own drawing, regardless of what it looks like.



10. As you start drawing your radiating lines from the circle you may want to help each other with them. You can let your child know that you would like some help with your radiating lines or some other part of the picture.



11. Sign and date your masterpieces and keep the best ones so you and your child can see the process of development over the years.
